Yreka City Manager confirms essential services will continue in Yreka while complying with Governors Statewide Stay at Home order for the remainder of City services.

California Governor Newsom's Statewide Stay at Home order was announced Thursday, March 19, 2020. In accordance with this order, Yreka City Hall will be closing until further notice, effective Monday, March 23, 2020.

Yreka City Manager Steve Baker confirms that essential services will remain in place in the City of Yreka during the closure of City Hall.

Water and wastewater will remain fully operational with limited changes.

Many services including building and encroachment permits, planning applications, and other services will be available by appointment only.

Utility customer service, payment processing, and other services will be available online, by phone, payment drop-box and by appointment.

Police and Fire services will remain in place with no changes to emergency calls. However, non-emergency calls may be handled via phone or online as deemed necessary.

It is the City of Yreka's goal to share the most up-to-date information on how this will impact City departments and the public at ci.yreka.ca.us.
