Discussion:

At the meeting of March 16, 2017, it was reported that Councilmember David Simmen submitted a letter of resignation effective March 12, 2017. Staff outlined the process for appointment of a councilmember, reporting that State Statutes do not identify the details of the appointment process; however, Government Code Section 36512 requires that upon vacancy of a City Council seat, the City Council can either appoint a replacement within 60 days or call for a special election.

The Council directed the City Clerk to advertise and accept applications to fill the unexpired term of Councilmember David Simmen with a deadline of April 5, 2017. The City Clerk reports applications were received by the following City residents:
