

Yreka Community Center & Theater Alcoholic Beverage Policy-

Should alcoholic beverages be served at an event, whether by a licensed provider or by the lessee themselves, it is the responsibility of the lessee to ensure that alcoholic beverages are not made available to persons under the age of 21. The Yreka Community Center is a public, City-owned facility; the lessee is a private party sponsoring an event in a public facility. Therefore, the lessee and the licensed provider, if one is engaged, must respect laws forbidding minors to consume alcoholic beverages. Should a licensed provider be found to be selling alcoholic beverages to minors, its license shall be revoked and a large fine levied. Should a lessee allow alcoholic beverages to be provided to minors, criminal charges may be filed and a large fine levied. Should Community Center personnel become suspicious of any illegal activity, it is their duty and responsibility to inform the lessee of their concerns. This allows the lessee the opportunity to alleviate the potential problem. If the lessee is unable to control the situation, it is then the duty and responsibility of the Community Center personnel to the contact the Yreka Police Department. It has been the policy of the Yreka Police Department to make a walk-through if there are concerns regarding the compliance of lessees during events at the Community Center. A walk-through should NOT be construed as a threat or inconvenience to the lessee, but as support and assistance to the welfare of all involved.
