

CITY OF YREKA CURRENT CREEK PROJECTS - July 2013

North Yreka Creek Trail Development Project #1

Location: Along Deer Creek Way

Description: Construct 1/2 mile of multipurpose trail with parking lot, restrooms, picnic areas, floodplain restoration, habitat enhancements, and interpretive signs. Construction anticipated in 2014.



Yreka Creek Flood Hazard Reduction Project (North Reach) #2

Location: 0.41 mile reach between E. Lennox and State Route 3


Description: Acquire 29 acres of land. Eleven acres will be lowered to create a much larger and more accessible re-vegetated floodplain. Grant agreements signed, moving to design phase.



Yreka Creek Flood Hazard Reduction Project (Central Reach) #3

Location: 0.23 mile reach next to the Klamath National Forest Service Center and the County Museum

Description: Restore 2.1 acres of floodplain. Remove/relocate existing buildings (5) and retaining wall, replace bridge at KNF's yard. Grant agreements signed, moving to design phase.



North Yreka Creek Trail Development Project (Visitor Center Enhancement) #4

Location: Greenway Visitor Center

Description: Revise outdoor classroom, construct an interpretive/events station, sound barrier, sculptures, landscaping, irrigation. Construction anticipated in 2014



Oberlin Road Trail Project #5

Location: Oberlin Road to the Klamath National Forest Service Center

Description: Floodplain restoration, modification of storm drain outlet, and culvert near Mount Shasta Title. Construct parking lot at trailhead, install picnic tables, trash receptacles, signs and a drinking fountain. Construct approx. 3/4 miles of trail, and install bridges along the creek. Currently in design phase.



Yreka Creek Flood Hazard Reduction Project (South Reach) #6

Location: 0.58 mile reach between Oberlin Road and Sharps Road

Description: Purchase Eleven acres of property and possibly restore floodplain, depending on funding availability. Grant agreements signed, moving to design phase.
