THE POSITION

The City of Yreka is accepting applications for the position of Police Officer – Yreka Police Department. Individuals in this classification perform general law enforcement duties including, but not limited to, patrol assigned to enforcing laws and maintaining order, traffic law enforcement, regulation enforcement, crime prevention and crime investigation from complaint to final solution of cases.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS

- 1) Graduate from a P.O.S.T. Certified Academy or a Lateral Police Officer
- 2) Possess a current and valid California Driver's License must provide DMV driving record with application.
- 3) Must be a U.S. citizen or meet the requirements of Government Code 1031
- 4) 21 years of age or older
- 5) Possess a high school diploma or equivalent

EXAMINATION PROCEDURE

- 1) Oral board exam
- 2) Physical agility test
- 3) May require a Personnel Evaluation Profile (PEP) test
- 4) Police Chief's interview
- 5) Medical exam by a physician and psychological screening
- 6) Criminal History and Background Check: Applicants will be fingerprinted for the purpose of a search of local, state and national fingerprint files to disclose any criminal record.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Interested individuals must submit a City of Yreka Police employment application to the Police Department in order to be considered. Applications not received by the Police Department by the close of the recruitment may not be considered.
