City of Yreka Launches Interactive Financial Transparency Platform
OpenGov platform engages residents with instant access to financial data

Sept. 3 – Yreka, CA– Today the City of Yreka announces its new interactive financial analysis platform powered by OpenGov.com. The website provides residents, elected officials and staff a new way to access the city’s finances. The easy to use graphical reporting tools help simplify financial data into an interactive, digital format that enables the reader to better understand of the city’s finances. Now anyone can explore how taxpayer money is collected and spent. The platform may be accessed at <https://yrekaca.opengov.com>

The OpenGov platform displays the past 6 years of the City’s revenues and expenses in a user-friendly website portal. Website visitors can view historical revenue and expenditure trends over time and explore multiple views of financial data, including sorts by fund, function, expense or revenue type. The current year report provides insight into spending and revenues year-to-date. For example, visitors to the platform may answer frequently asked questions such as “How much does the city spend annually on public safety?” or “How much does the city collect from water fees?” and then share that information directly from the platform via email or on social media.

Finance Director Rhetta Hogan and Intern David Neill worked on this project to make the city’s finances more transparent and understandable.

With today’s announcement, Yreka joins a growing list many cities, counties, state agencies, school systems, and special districts across the country that leverage OpenGov technology in the financial transparency movement.


