(144 sq. ft.) empty sign cabinet; relocate existing double sided 12 ft. 8 in. x 9 ft. 9 in. (123.5 sq. ft. per side) Best Western sign cabinet to the vacant pole, the sign will be 65 feet high; and remove old Best Western pole to grade. Two signs located on the freeway pole sign have been removed (Denny’s and Best Western).
