YPD is currently staffed with 14 sworn personnel and is open 24 hours a day, seven days a week to serve our community. They also offer free services to the community, such as child car seat inspections, free car seats to those in need, and bike helmets for children.

## Yreka Volunteer Fire Department

The tradition of a Volunteer Fire Department has been preserved for its entire 152-year history. Today, the Department is authorized to have 50 volunteers and the active roster consists of about 30 members. The operations and volunteers of the Department are managed by an Executive Board of seven members. Yreka's volunteer firefighters respond to an average of 1,000 incidents per year.

### Public Works Department Maintenance Division

The Maintenance Division maintains approximately 52 centerline miles of streets, 82 miles of water distribution pipes, 48 miles of sanitary sewer system pipes and the storm drain system. The Division also maintains the parks, streetlights, and City buildings.



### Public Works Department Wastewater Treatment Plant

The primary responsibility of the Wastewater Treatment Plant is to operate and maintain the Plant that treats and disposes of the domestic and industrial wastewater that is generated within the City. The Plant operators are certified with the State of California Water Resources Control Board.



### Public Works Department Water Division

The Water Division monitors and maintains the water supply and treatment system on a 24/7 basis to ensure that water entering the distribution system meets all State and Federal standards for drinking water quality. The Division's operators are certified with the State of California, Department of Public Health, and are dedicated to providing a safe, clean, and adequate supply of potable water to the residents of Yreka.



### Public Works Department Fleet Management

Fleet Management provides the City of Yreka with safe, reliable vehicles and equipment so that all Departments can perform their work efficiently and safely.
