Street Projects

1. **Project Name:** Downtown Bicycle and Pedestrian Path
Total Project Cost: \$ 663,119
Funding Sources: Transportation Enhancement Activities (TEA) (grant) \$466,995; State Transportation Account grant match \$29,364; City of Yreka, \$166,760
Description: Install curb, gutter, sidewalk and Class 2 bike lanes along Foothill, Miner Street, and Center Streets between Main Street and the YMCA.
Status: completed November 1, 2006
2. **Project Name:** Downtown Bicycle and Pedestrian Path, Phase 2
Total Project Cost: \$ 115,000
Funding Sources: Transportation Enhancement Activities (TEA) (grant) \$102,000 State Transportation Account (grant) match \$13,000
Description: **Complete** installation of curb, gutter, sidewalk and Class 2 bike lanes at Kleaver, West Center, and North Foothill
Status: construction anticipated 2008
3. **Project Name:** Oberlin and Fairlane Road Rehabilitation
Total Project Cost: \$836,219
Funding Source: State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) (grant)
Description: Rehabilitate pavement base and install new asphalt surfacing on Oberlin between the easterly City Limit and Main Street and on Fairlane Roads, between Oberlin and the southerly City Limit.
Status: construction completed June 2007 , striping to be completed by July 15
4. **Project Name:** Greenhorn Road Reconstruction
Total Project Cost: \$998,630 (estimate)
Funding Source(s): State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) (grant)
Description: Install new sewer and storm drain pipes, realign a portion of the roadway to minimize hills and corners, reconstruct roadway base and install new asphalt surfacing between Lucas Road and the westerly City Limit.
Status: projected completion date is September 28, 2007
5. **Project Name:** 2006 Street Rehabilitation
Total Project Cost \$ 342,622 (estimate)
Funding Source: State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) (grant)
Description: Install double chip seal pavement treatment on numerous City streets between Main and the westerly edge of town. Streets include: Center, Miner, Lane, North, Annie, Lange Way, Silva Ct, Blake, Hiram Page, Northridge Ct, Ranch Lane, South, Oak, and Oak View Circle.
Status: construction completed June 25, 2007

6. **Project Name:** Fourth Street
Total Project Cost \$572,000 (estimate)
Funding Source: State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) (grant)
Description: Install new asphalt surface.
Status: design underway, construction scheduled for 2008/09
7. **Project Name:** 2007 Overlays
Total Project Cost \$738,000 (estimate)
Funding Source: State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) (grant)
Description: Install new asphalt surface on various streets.
Status: design underway, construction expected in 2009
8. **Project Name:** Safe Routes to Schools
Total Project Cost \$440,000 (estimate)
Funding Source: State Transportation Safe Routes to Schools (SR2S) (grant) \$396,000; City gas tax match \$ 44,000
Description: Install ADA curb ramps and high-visibility school signage and pavement markings. Streets include: Evergreen, North Oregon, West Lennox, North Gold, Middle, Jackson, Miner, and Yama Streets
Status: design underway, construction expected 2008
9. **Project Name:** Allen Street Reconstruction
Total Project Cost \$ 111,829 (estimated)
Funding Source: City gas tax
Description: Grind and replace pavement base, install new asphalt surfacing and realign pavement to improve drainage on Allen Street, between the Warrens Avenue and East Lennox Street.
Status: construction completed June 8, 2007
10. **Project Name:** State Route 3 at Yreka- Ager Road and Quarry Ct. Left Turn Lanes
Total Project Cost \$700,000 (estimated)
Funding Source: City 1/3 from State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) (grant), Caltrans 2/3 from State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP)
Description: Construct left turn lanes.
Status: completed June 2007

Wastewater Projects

11. **Project Name:** Sewer Rehabilitation Phase 3
Total Project Cost \$ 1,000,000
Funding Source: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
Description: Repair, replace, and reline sewer trunk lines and laterals serving low-income households to reduce inflow and infiltration as recommended by the Water Board when it issued the 1998 Cease and Desist Order. Rehabilitated or replaced

approximately 2000 linear feet of 6-10" gravity sewers and laterals, and relined, cleaned and treated another 3000 LF.

Status: construction completed May 2007

12. **Project Name:** Wastewater Treatment Plant (9WWTP) Effluent Disposal Area Repair
Total Project Cost \$763,867 (estimate)
Funding Source: Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) (grant)
Description: Repair damages from 2005 flood events by replacing effluent disposal area leach field in 9 of 31 zones. Replacement of approximately 3600' of 3-4 foot piping and 130,000 feet of 1/2 inch dripline.
Status: construction expected to be complete by September 2007

13. **Project Name:** Wastewater Treatment Plant Sodium Hypochlorite Building
Total Project Cost \$235,000 (estimate)
Funding Source: Sewer Enterprise fund
Description: Install new control building, storage tanks, and associated equipment for new WWTP treatment process.
Status: design underway, construction completion by July 2007

14. **Project Name:** Wastewater Treatment Plant Expansion Plan
Total Project Cost \$ 66,950 (estimate)
Funding Source: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) \$35,000
Description: Develop conceptual alternatives for expanding or relocating the Waste Water Treatment Plan and design the selected alternative.
Status: design underway, no estimate available on construction date

Water Projects

15. **Project Name:** Water Treatment Controller software upgrade (SCADA)
Total Project Cost \$ 18,000
Funding Source: California Department of Health Services (grant)
Description: Install updates to old SCADA software to more effectively and remotely control filter plant pump operations in preparation of additional pumps to balance out the water delivery to storage tanks.
Status: completion expected Fall 2007

16. **Project Name:** Broadway Water Main
Total Project Cost \$494,898
Funding Source: Water Enterprise fund
Description: Install approximately 2000 linear feet of 12" PVC water main and service meters on Broadway Street, between Miner and Dillon Street.
Status: completed October 2006

Drainage Projects

17. **Project Name:** Stormwater Attenuation and Floodplain Restoration
Total Project Cost \$ 5,200,000 (estimate)
Funding Source: State Water Board Integrated Watershed Management Program Implementation (grant)
Description: Install three retention basins near westerly edge of town. Upgrade pipe sizes of storm drains at Yreka and Center Streets. Conduct floodplain excavation at Yreka Creek and dredge Greenhorn Reservoir.
Status: design underway, construction to be completed by June 2008

18. **Project Name:** Ecological Stormwater Mitigation Plan
Total Project Cost \$81,000 (estimate)
Funding Source: US Forest Service Resource Advisory Committee (RAC) (grant)
Description: Prepare an overlay of the City's Master Plan of Drainage to identify ecological treatment opportunities and make recommendations for drainage policy updates. Design small on-site retention demonstration project.
Status: field review underway

Park Projects

19. **Project Name:** Yreka Creek Restoration
Total Project Cost \$ 300,000
Funding Source: California Department of Water Resources Urban Streams (grant)
Description: Conduct floodplain restoration to increase stormwater storage, install native plants, and remove noxious weeds. Prepare plans for trail alignment between Fairgrounds and I-5. Purchase property for Yreka Creek Greenway.
Status: design underway, construction expected by May 2008

20. **Project Name:** Yreka Creek Trail and Visitor Center Upgrade
Total Project Cost \$ 1,501,000
Funding Source: California Resources Agency River Parkways (grant)
Description: Construct new trail and install trailhead with restrooms and parking along Yreka Creek north of Montague Road. Purchase property for Yreka Creek Greenway. Install landscape and irrigation improvements at the Yreka Creek Visitor Center.
Status: design starting, construction expected 2008/2009

21. **Project Name:** Greenhorn Creek Floodplain Restoration
Total Project Cost \$ 68,500
Funding Source: Partners for Fish and Wildlife (PFW) (grant)
Description: Plan floodplain restoration activities for Greenhorn Creek one mile above Greenhorn Reservoir.
Status: design starting, construction expected 2008/2009

22. **Project Name:** Greenhorn Creek Pedestrian Bridge Repair
Total Project Cost \$166,500 (estimate)
Funding Source: Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) (grant)
Description: Repair damaged pedestrian bridge abutments at Greenhorn Creek at Upper Greenhorn Park.
Status: design starting, construction expected 2008/2009

23. **Project Name:** Greenhorn Park Trail and Restroom Accessibility
Total Project Cost \$ 507,600 (estimate)
Funding Source: California Department of Parks and Recreation Roberti Z'Berg Harris (grant) \$296,000; City match \$211,600
Description: Install new year round ADA accessible restrooms, construct accessible trail around lake, and install new pedestrian bridge at spillway.
Status: design underway, construction expected 2008/2009

24. **Project Name:** Lewis and Ringe Park Playground Accessibility
Total Project Cost \$40,000
Funding Source: California Workforce Housing (WFH) (grant)
Description: Install accessible pathways to the playgrounds at Lewis and Ringe parks.
Status: construction in progress

25. **Project Name:** Miner Street Restrooms
Total Project Cost \$102,585
Funding Source: California Workforce Housing (WFH) (grant)
Description: Install accessible public restrooms in downtown area.
Status: design starting, construction expected in 2008

26. **Project Name:** Senior Transit Bus Purchase
Total Project Cost \$ 250,000
Funding Source: California Uniform Transit (grant)
Description: Replace three aged senior transit buses.
Status: buses ordered, delivery due anytime

27. **Project Name:** Transit Bus Barn
Total Project Cost \$ 410,000
Funding Source: California Uniform Transit (grant)
Description: Design and construct a 5 bay bus barn.
Status: construction expected 2008 -2010
