3. GENERAL PUBLIC COMMENTS:

This is the time for public comments regarding issues or matters not on the agenda but still within the jurisdiction of the City Council or Planning Commission of Yreka. Public comments period is not intended to be “Question and Answer” period or conversations with the Commissioners or City staff. Commissioners, when recognized by Chair, may ask questions of presenter but no action may be taken by the Planning Commission during the public comment section of the meeting, except to direct staff to prepare a report or place an item on a future agenda.

4. GENERAL PLAN 2044: VISIONING WORKSHOP

This item will be a presentation and interactive session on visioning for the General Plan update. The session will begin with a transgenerational activity that looks at the needs of all generations for the next 5-, 10-, and 20-years. The session will then look at the results of the General Plan visioning survey and draft a vision statement for future Planning Commission and City Council consideration.

Action: Give direction on draft 2044 City of Yreka vision statement.

5. ADJOURNMENT

In compliance with the requirements of the Brown Act, notice of this meeting has been posted in a publicly accessible place, 72 hours in advance of the meeting.

Decisions of the Planning Commission may be appealed to the City Council by filing a written notice of appeal within ten (10) calendar days of the decision. Appeals must be submitted to the City Clerk’s office together with the appeal fee. If you challenge any action taken pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the Planning Department at, or prior to, the public hearing. (Public Resources Code Section 21177). If, in the future, you wish to challenge in court any of the matters on an agenda for which a public hearing is to be conducted, you may be limited to raising only those issues which you (or someone else) raised orally at the public hearing or in written correspondence received by the City at or

before the hearing. Any person seeking to challenge a City Council decision made as a result of a proceeding in which by law a hearing is required to be given, evidence is required to be taken, and the discretion in the determination of facts is vested in the City Council, shall be required to commence that action 90 days following the date on which the decision becomes final as provided in Code of Civil Procedure Section 1094.6. Please refer to Code of Civil Procedure 1094.6 to determine how to calculate when a decision becomes "final."
