**4. GENERAL PLAN 2044: VISIONING WORKSHOP**


This item will be a presentation and interactive session on visioning for the General Plan update. The session will begin with a transgenerational activity that looks at the needs of all generations for the next 5-, 10-, and 20-years. The session will then look at the results of the General Plan visioning survey and draft a vision statement for future Planning Commission and City Council consideration.


**Action:** Give direction on draft 2044 City of Yreka vision statement.

Community Development Director, Juliana Lucchesi guided workshop participants into work groups (charrettes) to engage in understanding transgenerational needs and characteristics. By the workshop's end, each table had summarized their findings and recommendations for the six characterized generational needs based on the table participants' discussion. Ms. Lucchesi, Community Development Director received the written documents for consideration and input into the 2044 City of Yreka vision statement.
