City Hall Closed to the Public on Fridays

City Hall, located at 701 Fourth Street, will be closed to the public on Fridays effective May 30, 2014, on a trial basis. Emergency services will operate normally.

With City staff reductions over the past few years, the City needs to adjust certain levels of service to continue operations. Closing to the public one day per week will help staff better meet current challenges by increasing staffing flexibility and the amount of time staff can focus on a variety of special projects and training. Closing

on Fridays should provide the least disruption. Staff will still respond to water main breaks, sanitary sewer overflows and other emergencies.

Water shut-offs due to delinquent bills will occur only on Monday through Wednesday. The City is currently working to increase payment options for utility customers, including web-based credit card payments and other online features that will enable customers to view account information and to pay bills online.

For medical, fire or police emergencies, call 911.

For water/sewer emergencies on Friday-Sunday, holidays or after regular business hours, contact the Yreka Police Department at (530) 841-2300.
