## Public Works Updates

### Work Starting on City of Yreka Parking Lots in September 2020

On July 2, 2020, the Yreka City Council awarded a construction contract to Advantage Paving and Excavating, Inc. of Yreka for the improvement of two City parking lots. The first is located on the northwest corner of West Center Street and Fourth Street, and the second is on the northwest corner of North Street and Third Street.

Weather dependent, construction is scheduled for September 2020 and is estimated at two weeks. When a definite start date has been determined, that information and other updates will be posted on the City of Yreka website at [www.ci.yreka.ca.us](http://www.ci.yreka.ca.us). Any street closures will be posted and nearby businesses will be notified at least 72 hours before work begins. Please contact Project Manager Cynthia Lynch at (530) 841-2326 with any questions.

## Fall Leaves & Yard Debris



The City of Yreka is once again asking for your help in keeping the Storm Drains flowing this Fall.

Public Works sweeps the streets as frequently as possible when leaves are actively falling in an effort to keep storm drain pipes flowing. **However, the Street Sweeper is not intended for leaves.** It is one method we use to stay in compliance with our State-issued Storm Water Permit by removing fine sediment and small items of trash blown around by the wind.


Flooding problems in the street and on private property occur when leaves from private property enter the City

Storm Drain System. Placing or blowing your leaves into the street is against the California Vehicle Code and City of Yreka Municipal Code.

We encourage you to dispose of your leaves by composting or mulching, but you can also haul them to the Transfer Station. Yreka Community Gardens typically has two leaf collection days in October or November, depending on when the leaves fall. ### CodeRED Emergency Alert System

**All residents and businesses are encouraged to sign up for the CodeRED emergency alert system. You will be notified by your local emergency response team in the event of emergency situations or critical community alerts. Examples include: evacuation notices, bio-terrorism alerts, boil water notices and missing child reports. To receive emergency information, download the free app on your iPhone or Android. You can also sign up on the internet by visiting our website and searching for CodeRED. If you need administrative assistance signing up, contact the Yreka Police Department at (530) 841-2300. You can choose to receive alerts by text, phone call, and/or email.**
