CITY COUNCIL MEETING
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Yreka City Council will hold a public hearing at **6:30 p.m., Tuesday, August 16, 2022** in the Council Chambers, 701 Fourth Street, Yreka, California, or via Zoom for those who cannot attend in person. The Zoom link will be available on the Planning Commission agenda a minimum of 72 hours prior to the meeting, on the following proposed project:

Master Fee Schedule: IP-2022-01 Fee Schedule Update – The City of Yreka is proposing an update of the Master Fee Schedule for the 2022-2023 fiscal year. The update would cover fees in the Building, Planning, Finance, Public Works, Fire, and City Clerk departments. The fee schedule update will be applied to applications and licensing of various uses, lots, and structures within the city. The proposed update would adjust fees up to account for Planning, Building, Fire, Public Works, and City Clerk staff time on applications, licenses, and private projects.

The proposed action has been determined to meet the guidelines for exemption under Section 15273(a)(1) “Rates, Tolls, Fares, and Charges” of the State California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines. The proposed fee schedule update is a statutory exemption; CEQA does not apply to the establishment, modification, structuring, or restructuring of rates, tolls, fares, or other charges by public agencies, including employee wage rates and fringe benefits.

The public is invited to review and comment on these matters. Detailed information on the above described application is on the City’s website at www.ci.yreka.ca.us/AgendaCenter for public review. All interested persons are invited to attend the meeting to participate in the public hearing or submit written comments regarding the proposed project on or before **4 p.m. August 16, 2022**, to the following address:

If you wish to challenge this matter in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice or written correspondence delivered to the hearing body at or prior to the public hearing. If substantial evidence has been presented demonstrating a more appropriate environmental determination than the one that has been recommended, the decision-making body may require and/or approve an alternative environmental determination pursuant to the requirements of CEQA. As comments are part of the official record of the project, please be sure that all comments submitted are legible and include the name of the author or signatory.
