

MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
YREKA HELD IN SAID CITY ON JULY 10, 2014

On the 10<sup>th</sup> day of July 2014, the City Council of the City of Yreka met in the City Council Chambers of said City in special session, and upon roll call, the following were present: Robert Bicego, Bryan Foster, Rory McNeil, and David Simmen. Absent – John Mercier.

Public Hearing: Discussion and Possible Action to: Adopt Resolution 2014-28 Calling for an Election on November 4, 2014 for City Voters to Determine Whether an Ordinance entitled “An Ordinance of the City of Yreka Imposing a Local Transactions and Use Tax to Improve the Quality of Life in Yreka” is Enacted; which Resolution 2014-28 Amends and Restates Resolution 2014-27 and Finds that the Enactment of the Measure is not Subject to CEQA.

This being the time and date scheduled for the public hearing, Mayor Simmen opened the public hearing. There being no comments or statements received, Mayor Simmen closed the public hearing and opened discussion to the Council.

Following Council discussion, Councilmember Bicego moved to adopt Resolution No. 2014-28 amending and restating Resolution No. 2014-27 Calling for an Election on November 4, 2014 to approve a one-quarter of one percent (0.25%) Transactions and Use (sales) tax to improve the quality of life for Yreka residents and a finding that the measure is not subject to CEQA.

Mayor Simmen seconded the motion, and upon roll call, the following voted YEA: Bicego, Foster, McNeil, and Simmen. Mayor Simmen thereupon declared the motion carried.

Following the reading of the title of the Ordinance and Council discussion, Mayor Simmen moved to waive the reading of the body of the Ordinance and to adopt Ordinance No. 838 subject to the approval of the Measure by the voters on November 4, 2014. Said Ordinance being entitled: “An Ordinance of the City of Yreka Imposing a Local Transactions and Use Tax to improve the Quality of Life in Yreka”.

Councilmember McNeil seconded the motion, and upon roll call, the following voted YEA: Bicego, Foster, McNeil, and Simmen. Mayor Simmen thereupon declared the motion carried.

**ADJOURNMENT** There being no further business before the Council the meeting was adjourned.
