MINUTES

The Commission having received a copy of the minutes of the regular meeting held September 10, 2009 the minutes were approved as presented, on a motion made by Commissioner Reather, seconded by Commissioner McCoy, all in attendance voting aye.

GENEALOGICAL SOCIETY OF SISKIYOU COUNTY – HISTORY FESTIVAL

The Commission discussed the request made by the Genealogical Society of Siskiyou County that the Commission participate in the first annual history festival to be held at the armory on the Siskiyou County Fairgrounds on Father's Day, June 20, 2010. Jill Harris suggested the possibility that the Commission share a booth with the Chamber. The Commission directed staff to notify the organizers that the Historic District and Landmarks Commission plan to participate in the event.

Chair Vanden Broeck appointed Commissioners Reather, O'Brien, and East to a committee to provide suggestions for a booth for the History Festival event. The organizers are trying to create a venue that can provide an understanding of our ancestor's daily lives. The Committee will report back to the Commission at the March 11<sup>th</sup> meeting.

### MINER STREET VITALIZATION

The Commissioners discussed Miner Street vitalization. Council Members Darrow and Simmen were in attendance and provided information on the current status of the Black's building and requested ideas from the Commission regarding:

1. Directional signage to the Historic District, to parking, and to amenities at a pedestrian level.
2. Theme for interpretive displays in the Historic District – Black's building.

The Commissioners agreed they would like to participate in developing a theme for interpretive displays in the Historic District. A committee will be appointed at the February meeting to work on the project.
